An “SF Pretty Boy” son out of a “Kansas” ewe. He stood third as a lamb at the 2019 Iowa State Fair. “Gwen,” shown on the cover is his 3/4 sister. His daughters are very fancy with an added element of bone, length, and thickness of top. Barry Bruce has a great set of lambs out of him.

## “Number TWO”

A “SchamWOW” son out of a line-bred ewe from one of our best ewe families. He stood second at both Iowa State Fair and NAILE in 2019. His daughters are some of the prettiest fronted, up-headed females we have raised.

We don't get far from the farm yet 'cause we're still waiting on our second shot, but visitors are always welcome. The plan is to hit the Midwest Sale, Iowa State Fair, NAILE, and Illini Bred Ewe Sales with consignments.
